Highlights

HISTORIC CENTER

Aguascalientes began to develop from main square today's "Plaza de la Patria", where the Government's and City's Hall are located and date from the 18th century. Opposite the plaza is the Cathedral with a Baroque-Salomonic style and aside is the Morelos Theatre.

MUSEUMS

Aguascalientes hosts museums where you can admire some of the most beautiful neoclassic style sculptures, engravings and renowned artistic works as it is the Aguascalientes Museum, the Contemporary Art Museum and the Regional Museum of History.

THREE CENTURIES PARK

A recreational, cultural and historic space, built on the grounds of the Old National Mexican Railroad Station. In this park we find the "Dancing Water Fountain", the Rail Road Museum and the Mural "La Maestranza", and the "Antigua Nave de Locomotoras" Exposition Center.

BROKEN CHRIST IN SAN JOSE DE GRACIA

Live a different experience when visiting the Broken Christ, 30 minutes of the city. This asymmetric sculpture of 25 meters is the fourth biggest Christ in the world and it was built on an island in the Presa Calles in the honor of the former old town.

MAGIC TOWN "REAL DE ASIENOS"

Founded on the year 1548, characterized by its mining landscapes, tunnels and the Lady of Bethlehem Parish Art Gallery with the Articulated Christ with over 400 years old, and the "Señor del Tepozan" Exconvent with a valuable altarpieces collection that represent the "Via Crucis" that date from the 18th. Century.

SAN MARCOS FAIR

Home of the most traditional and important fair of Mexico "San Marcos Fair" with over 180 years that begins culture and traditions to its people with the traditional "ferial", its princesses, bull fighting, cock fighting, music, commerce and lights show.
