## Highlights

### XTACUMBILXUNAAN CAVES - SPECTACLES OF LIGHT AND SOUND

The town of Hopelchen is composed of numerous natural resources and archaeological sites, like those of Dzibilnocac, Hochob, and Santa Rosa Ixtampac. You can access an underground cavity inside which you can observe stunning stalactite and stalagmite formations. This is a must see spot for lovers of natural.

### THE CAMPECHE CATHEDRAL

Without a doubt, the most important church in Campeche is the Cathedral. The main attraction of the Campeche Cathedral is its facade, which consists of a carved stone doorway with two bodies framed by two fluted pilasters on pedestals and a simple curved top with a wriggler on the shaft and the pilasters.

### THE XPUHIL ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE

Xpuhil is a Mayan name that comes from a herbaceous plant in the cyprus family that was found abundantly in the town, and known for its form as "Cat's Tail". The earliest evidence of human dwelling on the site dates from 400 B. C. The height of the area, mainly reflected in its architecture, seems to have been during the Late Classic time period. It is composed of approximately seventeen architectural groups, and several residential platforms, scattered throughout the length and breadth of its 5 km (3 mi) in size.
