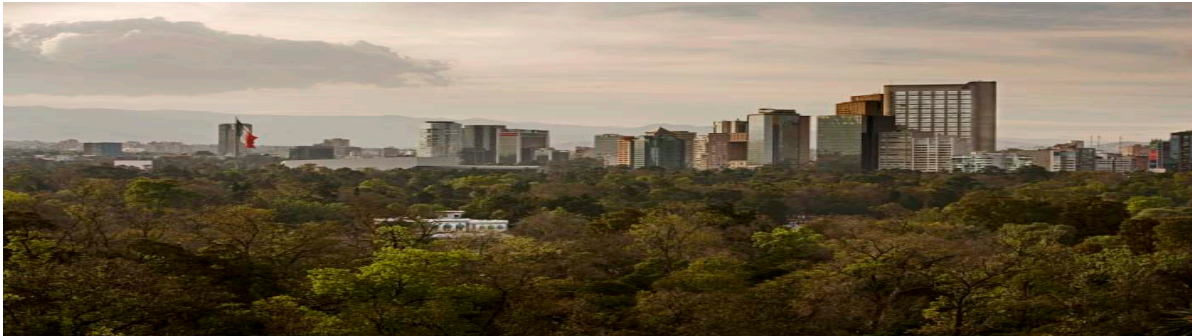

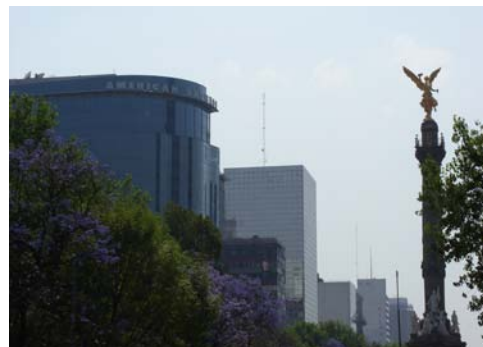

Highlights

COLUMN OF INDEPENDENCE

The base of the monument is square and its corners are represented in the Law, Justice, War and Peace. Also contains statues of some heroes of the Independence of Mexico, Morelos, Guerrero, Mina, and Bravo. It measures 36 meters high and on top is the Winged Victory, known as "The Angel", which is in his hand a laurel wreath. This angel measures 6.7 m, is of bronze covered with gold and weighs seven tons.



NATIONAL MUSEUM OF ANTHROPOLOGY

It covers an area of 93.371 m² divided into areas covered (exhibition halls, auditoriums, library, etc.) and outdoor (patios, gardens and parking). It displays the largest collection of pre-Columbian objects from different civilizations that inhabited the country. It is organized by geographical areas and cultural groups. It has a temporary exhibition hall and Jaime Torres Bodet Auditorium.



FORMER CHURCH OF ST. AUGUSTINE

The church was built of volcanic stone masonry, with a barrel vault, dome and support and octagonal stone arches. On the cover is placed a large relief of St. Augustine and was attached to the temple, the west side of the transept, the chapel of the Third Order, with a relief of Jesus Crucified on the second body.
