Highlights

MORELOS

The cosmopolitan, charming "city of the eternal spring," with its marvelous climate, flowers, swimming spots and lovely architecture always extend a warm welcome to visitors. Only 90 km from Mexico City, Cuernavaca is the jewel city in the state of Morelos. Its climate (average temperature is 20° C) and the crystalline waters of its swimming spots have attracted visitors from Mexico and all over the world for a very long time now.

MORELOS AND JUÁREZ GARDENS

The Juárez and Morelos Gardens are in the center of the city, both of which are plazas lined with trees. The Morelos Garden dates from 1908 and is easily recognizable by the large stone statue of José María Morelos, which is known colloquially as "Morelotes

The Garden contains a kiosk from England dating from the end of the nineteenth century. Unlike most main squares in Mexico, neither of these open up the way to the main cathedral. The main cathedral in Cuernavaca is located a few blocks west of the square.

SHOPPING IN CUERNAVACA:

There are many places to shop in Cuernavaca. We've included a few that are usually of interest to tourists:

Next door to the Palacio de Cortés is Mercado de Artesanias Zocalo an interesting and affordable crafts market offering items for sale from different states in Mexico. Cuernavaca is a center of "natural energy" and here you can buy stones, including onyx, quartz and natural crystals which come from the nearby Tepozteco Mountains.
